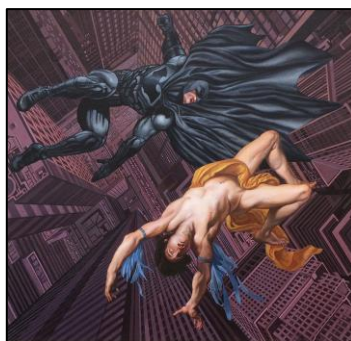
Gilles Clement Gallery to participate in Market Art + Design @ Bridgehampton Museum July 5-7, 2019

The signature technique of David Datuna's art is a network of positive and negative optical lenses suspended over a richly layered, collaged and painted image. A special installation of his monumental USA flag piece "Viewpoint of Billions" invites viewer engagement with scenes from American history and its iconic emblem. The mixed media palette includes photography, newspaper and magazine clippings and acrylic pigment. Focused on the convergence of art and social consciousness, and exploring the sources and meaning of cultural identity from unique points of view, Datuna's work, with its political, cultural and commercial commentary on the human collective consciousness, powerfully reflects the current social zeitgeist.

Serge Clement and Marina Kamena (Clement Kamena) have been making collaborative art in the contemporized spirit of Renaissance ateliers for over twenty years - a prolific body of work that reflects the couple's relentlessly dynamic, creative and visionary approach. First joining their talents to recreate ten masterpieces for the French film *Rembrandt* (1999), they have worked in tandem ever since, represented by and exhibited at the Allan Stone Gallery in NYC. On view will be their latest "Super Heroes" series of paintings, which feature the artists' playful mastery of content, illusion and perspective.

Gilles Clement Gallery presents a visionary mix of international contemporary artists, offering an exclusively curated collection of painting, photography, mixed media and sculpture. Paris native gallerist Gilles Clement organizes bi-monthly solo and group exhibitions featuring new media such as video sculpture, neon art and unconventional mediums, with an emphasis on Op-Art.
